Music Viva Excursion

On Wednesday, the students enjoyed a visit to Taralga Public where they participated in an Indonesian performance organised by Music Viva.

They learnt interlocking and unison techniques through instrumental and vocal percussion.

The instruments used, even though different to our instruments, had very similar features which the students could relate to. The drums differed through the use of two skins which were played by the hands and the foot.

The performers shared stories through music and dance. A Balinese monkey story had everyone chanting and swaying as they acted out the monkey soldiers rescuing the princess. The final story was performed with dramatic dance moves telling of a mythical bird that fights to save the environment.

Notice from the NSW Department of Transport

Applications for 2018 School Student Transport Scheme (SSTS) and Term Bus Pass (TBP) travel entitlements are now open.

In coming days students who hold an SSTS entitlement and are changing grade bands in 2018 i.e. going from year 2 to 3 or year 6 to 7 and changing schools, and students whose entitlement was approved under a medical condition, will receive notification by email or post informing them of the pending expiry of their entitlement.

Should you receive one of these notifications you need to go online to https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/updatedetails to update your details or make an application for next year's entitlement.

Applications need to be made before 31st December 2017 to ensure your entitlement is updated and not cancelled.
